We will aim to keep your personal information secure by taking appropriate technical and organisational measures against its unauthorised or unlawful processing and against its accidental loss, destruction or damage.

Taylor Wimpey UK Limited is committed to protecting your privacy and will not release your personal details or information to anyone outside the Taylor Wimpey group of companies except for use in connection with the proposals and/or activities being consulted upon, to let you know about any resulting new properties and other products or services, for research purposes and to help us develop our products and services.

We will keep your personal information until such time you contact us to request that it be removed or it is no longer required for archive purposes. We will aim to keep your personal information up to date, but rely on you telling us promptly if your name, address, telephone number or any other details change.

Some Taylor Wimpey websites use "cookies". These are text files stored on your hard disk by a web-page server. Where a cookie is used the cookie will not collect personally identifiable information without your explicit consent.
